## CANAAN BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014

Chairman, Bob Reagan called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM. In attendance were Selectmen Robert Reagan, Scott Borthwick, Dave McAlister, and Bob Scott.

Bob Scott and the Board of Selectmen reviewed Right Angle's prior experience writing FEMA grant applications. Erin Darrow indicated that she felt the Transfer Station bridge met a BCA (Benfit Cost Analysys) qualification of 1.4 and the Potato Road bridge met a qualification of 1.21. The Board discussed the relatively short time between the 11<sup>th</sup> and the 28<sup>th</sup>. The Board's concern about spending money on a project that they had previously hired HEB to do was too much risk for the Town. Bob Scott asked that he be allowed to get another opinion. The Board agreed and noted that we could submit after the next natural disaster which seems to be happening once a year.
